Ancient Falassarna

Falassarna Beach, on the western edge of Cape Gramvousa, is a beautiful blend of nature and history.

At its north end lie the ruins of the ancient **Greco-Roman city of Falassarna**, offering a glimpse into the past. Known as one of Greece's most famous beaches, Falassarna Bay has been named Crete's best and is among Europe's top ten.

The coastline stretches across five beaches, with the two in the middle being the most popular. **The largest, Pacheia Ammos**, is 1 km long and 150 meters wide, featuring soft white sand and clear turquoise waters—perfect for swimming and relaxing. Adventurers can explore the nearby rugged areas, while others can enjoy the calm and peaceful setting.

Facing west, Falassarna is a great spot to watch **Crete's stunning sunsets**. As the sun sets, the sky lights up with vibrant colors, reflecting off the sea—a peaceful moment you won't forget.

Please note that Rubbish disposal and taking seashells from the Beach is strictly prohibited
